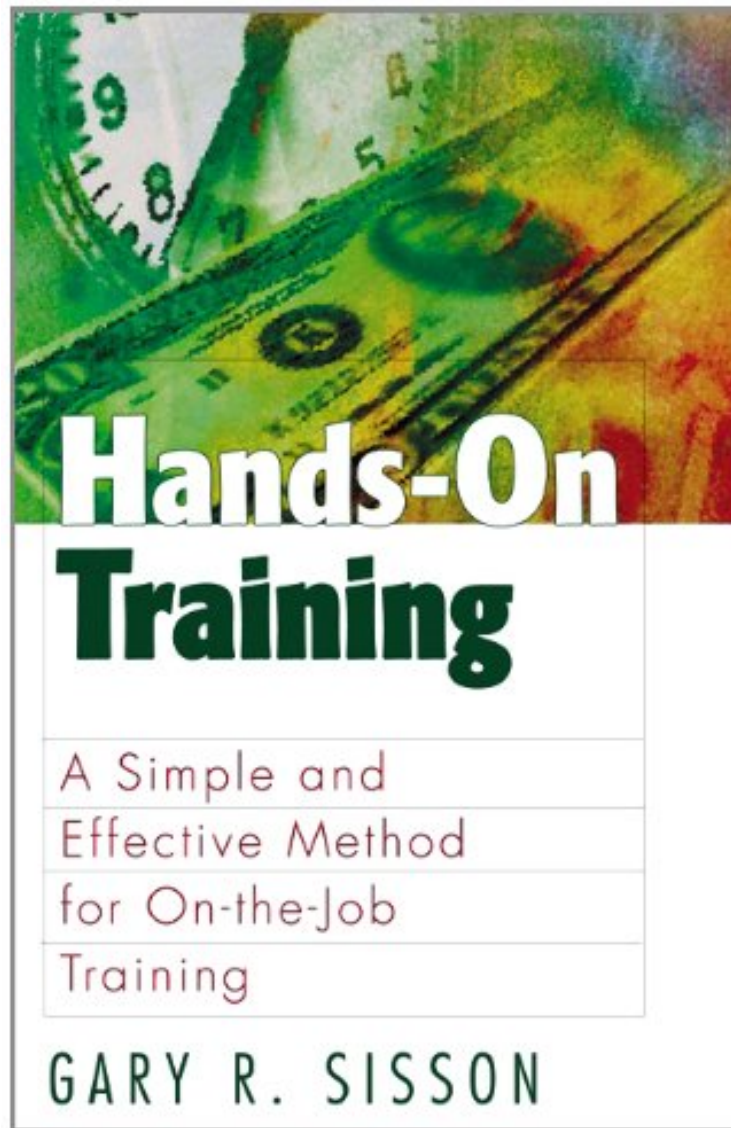


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Hands-On Training: A Simple and Effective Method for on the Job Training (Publication in the Berrett-Koehler Organizational Performance (Paperback))
