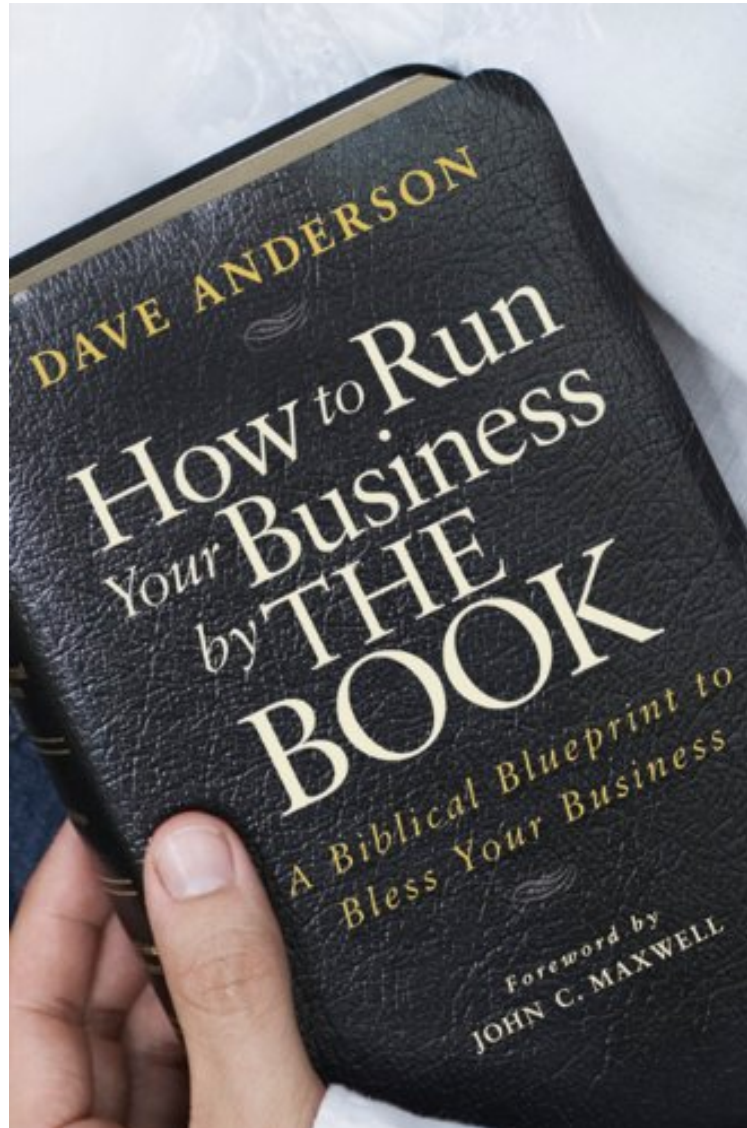

I support and agree with most of the messages in the book with the exception of debt and partnerships.
